Founded in 2010, the Sousa Mendes Foundation is dedicated to honoring the memory of the Holocaust rescuer Aristides de Sousa Mendes and to educating the public about his action. It has a two-fold mission: raising funds for the restoration of the Sousa Mendes ancestral home “Casa do Passal” along with the creation within its walls of a museum and memorial site, and sponsoring projects worldwide that perpetuate his legacy.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Thank you for your interest in the Sousa Mendes Foundation! We are dedicated to perpetuating the memory of the Holocaust hero **Aristides de Sousa Mendes**, Righteous Among the Nations. As the Portuguese Consul General in Bordeaux, France, he issued thousands of life-saving Portuguese visas in 1939 and 1940 to refugees seeking to leave Europe as the Nazis were overrunning the continent. In issuing these visas he went against the orders of his government, and simply followed his conscience.

“Their suffering was indescribable,” he said of the refugees in defending his action to his superiors. The Portuguese government responded with cold indifference and vengefulness, and punished the diplomat for defying orders. But Sousa Mendes had no regrets. “I could not have acted otherwise,” he told **Rabbi Chaim Kruger**, a leader and spokesman for the refugees.

In 2022 the Sousa Mendes Foundation spearheaded the dedication of **Aristides de Sousa Mendes Square** in Jerusalem. This project was the brainchild of **Dr. Mordecai Paldiel** on our Board of Directors, and you can read more about this event on the following pages.

We also continued offering our popular Sunday programs on **stories of rescue, resistance and hope**. You can see our wide array of documentary films and engaging speakers in the second half of this report.

FILM SERIES ON PORTUGUESE TELEVISION

The Sousa Mendes Foundation was a key partner in the creation of a fabulous five-episode documentary series, *Visas for Life: Aristides de Sousa Mendes* directed by **Lucia Gonçalves**, that aired in 2022 on the Portuguese television network SIC. This production featured Sousa Mendes visa recipients **Anka Muhlstein Begley, Jerry Brunell, Henri Dynner, Jorge Helft, Dr. Mordecai Paldiel, Dr. Mary Seeman, Michael Spett, Sylvia Verdi and Iva Wummer** as well as Sousa Mendes’s family members including his daughter **Marie-Rose Faure**, and the United Nations Secretary General **António Guterres** among others. We hope to present this moving and beautifully made series to our audience in 2023.



ARISTIDES DE SOUSA MENDES HONORED IN JERUSALEM

On November 8 and 9, 2022, the Portuguese diplomat and Holocaust rescuer **Aristides de Sousa Mendes** was honored in the city of Jerusalem in a series of events co-organized by the Sousa Mendes Foundation, the Jerusalem Municipality and Yad Vashem.

On Tuesday, November 8, a city square was dedicated in memory of Sousa Mendes, 82 years after his daring rescue action of June 1940. This memorial action is largely thanks to the efforts of the historian **Dr. Mordecai Paldiel** who serves on the Board of the Sousa Mendes Foundation and who was previously the Director of the Department for the Righteous at Yad Vashem.

The street sign was put in the ground two years ago, in June 2020, on the 80th anniversary of Sousa Mendes's rescue action, but without any ceremony at that time because of COVID restrictions. The sign is in Hebrew, Arabic and English, and reads: "Aristides de Sousa Mendes Square, Consul General of Portugal in Bordeaux (France), saved thousands of Jews during the years 1939-40."

Speakers included: **Mayor of Jerusalem Moshe Lion**, **Portugal Ambassador to Israel Jorge Cabral**, former **Israeli Ambassador to Portugal Colette Avital** and Yad Vashem representative **Dr. Joel Zisenwine**.

Earlier that day, there was a moving ceremony at Yad Vashem, where **Gerald Mendes** rekindled the eternal flame in remembrance of his grandfather, while a cantor sang blessings. There was also a gathering of the group at the Sousa Mendes tree on the Avenue of the Righteous.

On the following day, **Wednesday, November 9**, a symposium took place at the Vert Hotel in Jerusalem on the subject of **Aristides de Sousa Mendes and the Families He Saved**. Speakers included **Gerald Mendes**, **Dr. Avraham Milgram**, author of *Portugal, Salazar and the Jews*; and representatives of various families rescued by Aristides de Sousa Mendes. Stories were shared and tears were shed in this emotional and impactful event.

Many thanks to our planning committee listed on page 2, and most especially to Board member **Dr. Mordecai Paldiel** and our Jerusalem representative **Avi Losice**, for putting together a beautiful program.

ARISTIDES DE SOUSA MENDES HONORED IN PARIS

On September 28, 2022, at the initiative of the Paris City Council and the Comité français Aristides de Sousa Mendes, dignitaries, visa recipients and descendants gathered on the borders of Paris’ 8th and 17th districts to inaugurate the new Promenade Aristides de Sousa Mendes. Present at the ceremony were Sousa Mendes’ grandson **Gerald Mendes**, Mayor **Anne Hidalgo** of Paris, Mayor **Carlos Moedas** of Lisbon and the Secretary of State for Internationalisation of the Portuguese Republic, **Bernardo Ivo Cruz**, all of whom paid moving tributes to the man whose acts of moral courage saved thousands of lives. Board member **Monique Rubens Krohn** represented the Sousa Mendes Foundation at this event.

In 2022, the multimedia sculpture **Candelabro** – **Aristides de Sousa Mendes** travelled from the National Pantheon in Lisbon to the Musée d'Aquitaine in Bordeaux, France where it was part of a larger exhibition highlighting the events of May and June 1940. The Bordeaux exhibit was so successful that its stay was extended by several months and was seen by over 100,000 people! The sculpture is based on an idea by Sousa Mendes' grandson **Sebastian Michael Mendes** and created by German artist **Werner Klotz**, with an original soundtrack by German singer and composer **Almut Kühne**. The work evokes the fraught days during which Aristides de Sousa Mendes sequestered himself in his study as he wrestled with his conscience trying to decide what to do about the refugees who were seeking his help. The exhibits in Portugal and France were accompanied by educational activities for students and guided tours.

MEET OUR NEW INTERN FROM AUSTRIA



Valentin Hasler comes to us from Vienna under the auspices of the prestigious and competitive **Austrian Service Abroad** program, whereby Austrian young people work in Holocaust education in place of

their military service. He has been helping with our Sunday programs and has translated our graphic novel **Aristides de Sousa Mendes – Holocaust Hero** into German. He also works in our archive preserving and digitizing our collection of artifacts and photos.

I am proud to work for the Sousa Mendes Foundation, especially because the Foundation has a focus on the bright spots in such a dark story. I am looking forward to helping where I can to keep the legacy of our marvelous hero Aristides de Sousa Mendes alive.

MURALS IN CANADA AND PORTUGAL

Murals devoted to Aristides de Sousa Mendes have been created in Canada and Portugal! In Montreal, the Portuguese community commissioned artist **Matthew Cadoch** to create the mural, which was inaugurated in June 2022 in the presence

of the Canadian branch of the Sousa Mendes family. In Portugal, the organization Artists4Israel commissioned artist **Mr. Dheo** to create the mural in Vila Nova de Gaia, near Porto, as part of their Righteous Murals Project.

THE FUTURE SOUSA MENDES MUSEUM IN PORTUGAL

The project to create a memorial to Aristides de Sousa Mendes in **Casa do Passal**, the former home of the Sousa Mendes family in Cabanas de Viriato, advanced at an accelerated pace in 2022. The imposing mansion had fallen into ruin over several decades. Nevertheless, it was classified as a Portuguese National Monument in 2011, and the Ministry of Culture undertook the first phase of the re-qualification with emergency repairs to the walls and replacement of the roof in 2015.

Further public investment in the creation of the Museum was delayed by complex public procurement norms and Government budget restrictions, but construction finally resumed in mid-2022, based on a revised budget totaling EUR 2.8 million, after securing additional funding commitments from EU investment grants and the Portuguese Government budget.

The creation of the Museum is being spearheaded by the Municipality of Carregal do Sal under a contract of

comodato (lease) with the Portugal-based **Fundação Aristides de Sousa Mendes**, as owner of the property, and the Regional Directorate of the Ministry of Culture as the Heritage authority. This contract was recently extended to 2032.

On November 20, 2022, in the presence of the Minister of Culture **Pedro Adão e Silva**, the three museum project parties signed an agreement for the management of the future museum. The agreement names the US-based **Sousa Mendes Foundation** as a formal Partner Entity, in recognition of our active involvement, knowledge and collections and our potential contribution to “the development of the Aristides Sousa Mendes project, in particular to the Musealization of Casa do Passal.” The Foundation’s representatives on the museum project are Board members **Dr. Mordecai Paldiel** and **Mariana Abrantes**.

The construction is expected to conclude by the third quarter of 2023. The development of the museum program is advancing in tandem, with the museum projected to open in 2025.

STUDY VISIT TO PORTUGAL

In May of 2022, historian **Dr. Mordecai Paldiel** of our Board of Directors undertook a 10-day Study Visit to Portugal at the kind invitation of **Mayor Paulo Catalino** of Carregal do Sal, Portugal and with the generous support of the Luso-American Development Foundation (FLAD) and **Dr. Carlos Rodrigues**, a strong supporter of the Sousa Mendes cause.

The purpose of the visit was to meet with the Municipality of Carregal do Sal, the **Fundação Aristides de Sousa Mendes (FASM)** and the Regional Directorate of the Ministry of Culture (DRCC) – all stakeholders in the future Aristides de Sousa Mendes Museum.

Together with SMF Board Member **Mariana Abrantes** and **Cookie Fischer**, whose mother and cousins were saved thanks to Sousa Mendes visas, Professor Paldiel visited Jewish communities in Lisbon, Cascais and Porto. They

were joined by Mayor Catalino in the visit to the Memorial Frontier of Peace in Vilar Formoso and to the Jewish community of Belmonte which was hidden for over 500 years.

Dr. Paldiel spoke to students and teachers at the Sousa Mendes Middle School and gave lectures in the Diplomatic Institute of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and at the University of Coimbra, at the kind invitation of **Professor Avelãs Nunes** and the **Vice-Rector Claudia Cavadas**.

STORIES OF RESCUE, RESISTANCE AND HOPE

Our Sunday film-and-discussion series began in the early period of the COVID pandemic to provide inspiration, connection and hope. In 2022, we presented 36 programs and 92 speakers on a wide range of subjects. We were delighted to partner on some of these programs with the Jewish Foundation for the Righteous, the Monuments Men and Women Foundation, the University of Denver's Center for Art Collection Ethics, the Chambon Foundation, and the Jan Karski Educational Foundation.
